Dear Calvary friends,

I recently wrote my contribution for the annual report. It was a compendium, from my perspective, of the activities, issues, new programs and celebrations of 2022 for this congregation. There was a lot to write about!

So I will not be saying much in this space this month. Instead, go the Congregational Annual Meeting on Sunday, January 8th, which will take place directly after the worship service. At that meeting, you will vote on the new Church Council and the budget for 2023. I give my recommendations for both. But you should see for yourselves.

I have been to a bunch of congregational meetings in my lifetime, and they are usually interesting and productive. In times of internal conflict, they can be trying. But it is still important for the main governance of a congregation be grounded in assent by its members.

That said, some of you who are active at Calvary are not officially members. Becoming members is usually done as a part of worship. Ask me if you want to do that. But member or not, you should feel comfortable in coming to a congregation-wide meeting. Even if you can't vote, you can still make a difference.

I was just looking over the Sunday attendance of worship services here. I was pleased that, even though we pretty much began the year under COVID quarantine and mandatory masking, the final average worship attendance for the whole year was 33. That's good. And there about 50 total people who have a habit of coming to worship. And then, perhaps a couple dozen more people who belong to Calvary but aren't able, or have perhaps temporarily stopped coming, many of whom view the services on Facebook.

Speaking of Facebook, the number of views seems to average about 40 per Sunday. That may be duplicative, but still, about as many people who come to worship watch it online. That's good!

It feels good to be co-leading this congregation, where people's faith is alive, and curiosity as well.

Council Highlights

We have received a total of \$11,079.09 in donations and yard sale proceeds toward the heater replacement. Balance left to raise is \$385.91.

The lights in the Fellowship Hall Lighting in the Fellowship hall has been upgraded to LED bulbs. Total cost was \$1,030.18 less \$600.00 donated by Alice Kolb to pay for the labor. Net cost for Calvary = \$430.18.

The Council is still working on getting bids for cleaning the tile floors and washing the high windows.

Annual Report is due and will be presented at the Annual Meeting on January 8.



As of November 30, 2022 - Income - \$12,623.00. Expenses - \$8,317.11. Income was at 122.10% of the 2022 Budget for the eleven (11) months ending 11/30/2022. Expenses were at 104.10% of the 2022 Budget for the same period.

Outreach Committee
